## **Creating Web Pages II--Basics of Cascading Style Sheets**

If you've taken "Creating Web Pages I--Basics of HTML" or have basic knowledge of HTML, this hands-on workshop will add to your skills and knowledge. You'll learn how to use Cascading Style Sheets (CSS) to style your web pages. CSS is a powerful way to separate web page layout (style) from HTML structure (content). This workshop covers the basic elements and uses of CSS as supported in common browsers. (Note: Dreamweaver is used but it is not necessary to know how to use it to take this class.) (This is part of the Web Design Certificate Program, but you do not need to enroll in the program to take this workshop.)

## **Photoshop for the Web**

Using Photoshop, explore how to create gifs, transparent gifs, and jpegs, and when to use each. Learn the uses of dithering, interlacing, anti-alias, jpeg compression, dpi, color palette options, and more. Learn the secrets to great web photos and images. In the afternoon, you'll put together a web page design. You'll begin with a design idea implementing Photoshop's powerful type and imaging tools. Have your design idea sketched out on paper so you will be ready to work on it. Bring a CD to class with any scanned images you want to use. Also bring a blank CD to save your work. Familiarity with using Photoshop and some understanding of web page development is necessary. (This is part of the Web Design Certificate Program, but you do not need to enroll in the program to take this workshop.)

In this hands-on workshop, you will learn the essential basics of Dreamweaver, including the fundamental tools for creating individual pages and publishing web sites. This workshop is for beginning Dreamweaver users. A basic knowledge of HTML and/or web design is helpful, but not essential. (Cost includes \$35 for text.) (This is part of the Web Design Certificate Program, but you do not need to enroll in the program to take this workshop.)
